RIGHTS REQUIRE FULFILMENT

WE ALL "HAVE" THEM

BUT WE DON'T ALL ENJOYTHEM

HOW PARLIAMENTARIANS CAN FULFIL RIGHTS:

- ENGAGE IN DIALOGUE WITH THOSE WHO HAVE,
 TO LEARN HOW DOING SO IS POLITICALLY FEASIBLE
 - RECOGNIZE THEM IN LAW, POLICY AND CUSTOM
- INCLUDE ALL/TREAT ALL EQUALLY IN PROTECTION
 - ENUMERATE OVERLOOKED GROUPS
 - REPEAL PUNITIVE/DISCRIMINATORY PROVISIONS
- REMOVE OTHER BARRIERS TO ENJOYMENT OF RIGHTS
 - ENSURE REDRESS/JUSTICE FOR VIOLATIONS

 MACHINERY ACCESS
 - PROMOTE THEIR PROMOTION AND DEFENCE

HOW PARLIAMENTARIANS CAN FULFIL RIGHTS:
