Responsible institute for cyber Crime in Suriname

- THE DIRECTORATE NATIONAL SECURITY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CYBER SECURITY IN SURINAME
- A CYBER CRIME UNIT IS BEING CREATED WITHIN THE NATIONAL POLICE

Cyber security is under the custody of the President

- ☐ The President has a program of reducing computer related crime by harmonizing national Laws.
- □International cooperation

Cyber security workshop in cooperation with CARICOM Implementation Agency for Crime and Security (IMPACS). Funded by the development fund of European Unie (EDF)

Strategy: capacity building for CARIFORUM-member state.

Aim:

- -To reduce cyber security risk and to improve mechanisms for providing cyber security.
- -To amend law and research methods to improve cyber security according to international standards.

Steps to prevent cyber crime

- □Cooperation of the Republic of Suriname and Brazil, July 17, 2018
- Cooperation in the area of cross-border crime, and the approach to digital security and cyber crime.

Between the two countries:

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):

An Interinstitutional collaboration between the Suriname Police Force and The Brazilian Federal Police.

Capacity Building programs and identification of training in transnational crime

Steps to prevent cyber crime

Cooperation of the Republic of Suriname and Brazil, July 17, 2018

■Main goal of the meeting was to make sure that Security standards and procedures of digital security is ensure secure, and

☐ To help protect the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of computer systems, networks and data, against cyber-attacks or unauthorized access.

The result of the Cooperation:

The cooperation was successful

Conclusion

- □Electronic transactions act amended on Augustus 18, 2017
- PENAL CODE of Suriname forbidden any form of cyber crime
- □Suriname is member of the International Multilateral Partnership Against Cyber Threats.

The <u>Criminal Code</u> of 2015 implements most of the offences listed in the Budapest Convention.

Criminal Code of 2015 brought legislation largely in line with Budapest Convention.

Specific legislation on child online protection has been enacted through the following instrument: - Article 292* of the Criminal Code — only for children under 16.
